Notice of Continuation of Local Disaster Declaration

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, Rick Tennant, Judge of Roberts County, Texas, in accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code, declared a state of disaster and public health emergency for Roberts County, to wit: that public gatherings greater than 10 people be postponed or canceled ("Disaster Declaration").

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, at a duly called special meeting of the Roberts County Commissioners Court a motion was duly made and seconded; and the Commissioners Court of Roberts County unanimously ordered that the Disaster Declaration be renewed and continued until April 13, 2020.

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020, at a duly called meeting of the Roberts County Commissioners Court a motion was duly made and seconded; and the Commissioners Court of Roberts County unanimously ordered the Disaster Declaration be renewed and continued indefinitely. Upon a further motion and seconded; and the Commissioners Court of Roberts County unanimously ordered the Roberts County Judge be given the authority to rescind and revoke the Disaster Declaration at any time that may be appropriate based on guidance of local, state, and federal authorities.


NOW, THEREFORE, Roberts County, Texas, by and through her Commissioner Court does hereby certify that COVID-19 continues to poses an imminent threat of disaster to Roberts County. In accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code, and does hereby continue to declare a state of disaster and public health emergency for Roberts County.

Furthermore, consistent with guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), I recommend, following the Presidents guidance, that public gatherings greater than 10 people be postponed or canceled.


The Disaster Declaration shall Continue in effect indefinitely, until rescinded and revoked by the Roberts County Judge.

In accordance with the statutory requirements, this declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Roberts County.

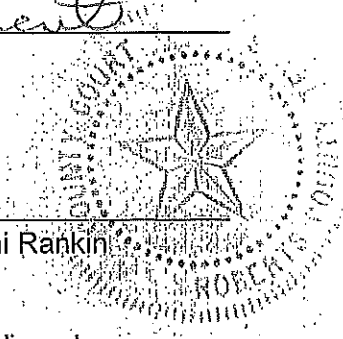
