WHY REGISTER

Storm shelters, whether an underground shelter, above ground shelter, or basement, are the best place to be during severe weather. If a storm impacts your home, however, debris could prevent you from leaving the shelter afterwards. First responders will check each home for survivors. They need to know if there's a shelter on the property that needs to be checked as well.
