Pursuant to the Laws and Rules of the State of Texas, Section 26.002 of the Texas Government Code and Article V, Section 29 of the Texas Cosntitution, the Commissioners Court of Roberts County finds that it is necessary update and adopt reasonable terms of court for the Roberts County Court, a constitutional county court, to conduct civil and criminal business.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT the Roberts County Court shall hold at least for terms annually for the conduct of civil and criminal business. The four terms of court are as follows:

FIRST TERM: beginning on the first day of February and ending on the last day of April;

SECOND TERM: beginning on the first day of May and ending on the last day of July;

THIRD TERM: beginning on the first day of August and ending on the last day of October; and

FOURTH TERM: beginning on the first day of November and ending on the last day of January.
